The 1868 Treaty of Ft. Laramie guaranteed the Black Hills to the Sioux forever.

However, when gold was discovered there in 1874, all bets (as well as the treaty) were

off! President Grant and his administration had to find a way to get the land back from

the Sioux - the end result: The Great Sioux War of 1876-77, the costliest Plains Indian

War in history. President Grant, George Custer, Sitting Bull, Crazy Horse and many

others were known names that contributed to this shady part of our nations' history.
